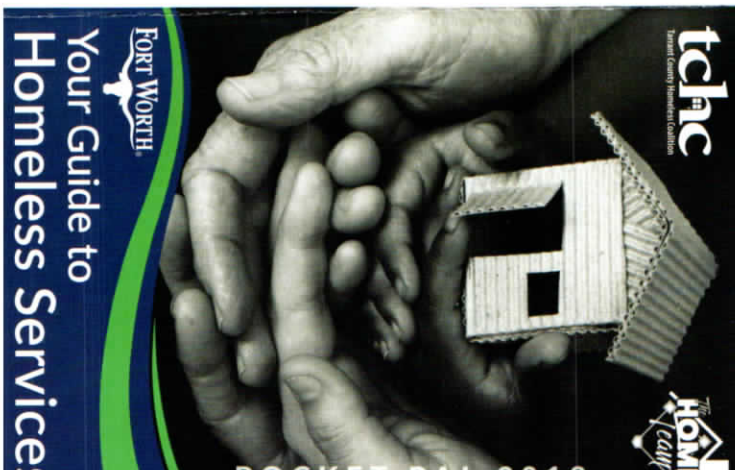
Step 2: Get connected to services
