The Allocations Committee met on Thursday, August 30, 2018 to review and rank project applications for the local FY18 CoC Program Competition. This email is the official notice that 40 of 42 applications have been accepted, ranked and will be included in the application to HUD that will be submitted to HUD by TCHC. 2 applications were rejected.

The committee made decisions pursuant and according to the TX601 CoC Ranking and Reallocation policies and unanimously voted to accept the attached ranked projects.

The committee ranked projects based on:

- Project Performance
- Community Need
- Population Served
- Geography Covered

The committee reallocated projects based on:

- Project Performance
- Prior Recapture Rate

The committee rejected projects based on:

- Demonstrated Community Need

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s Notice of Funding Availability ([NOFA](#)) for the 2018 Continuum of Care Program Competition (FR-6000-N-25), this notification informs applicants of the status of their project application(s) in the Fort Worth/ Arlington/ Tarrant County Continuum of Care TX601 local competition. On Thursday, August 30, 2018, the Allocations Committee reviewed, accepted or rejected, and ranked local project applications to produce the Final Project Priority Ranking list that is attached as a PDF document and has been uploaded to the TCHC website.
